Look at your calendars and mark them for our next Walks. We have made a change in the order of events due to some scheduling conflicts and unavoidable issues. As members of the board we made the best decision that we could. This fall the women's walk will come first followed by the men's. It is my understanding that we have done this one other time in history. The Women's Walk will be led by Nancy Lineberry and is October 9th – 12th. The Men's Walk will be led by Bill Younger and is October 16th – 19th.

As we have moved into the computer age we have found that we have a need for a minimum of one laptop, one printer, and one projector to connect to the PC. Each walk that we have we are borrowing this equipment and it is time that we look into purchasing equipment for the community. Ideally we would have two laptops and two projectors so that the men and women could both have one to preview talks with. Many people want to use PowerPoint along with their talk and the Upper Room requires that all talks are to be previewed including the PowerPoint presentation. In order for us to be able to have the necessary equipment for both teams this would increase our cost to the community. I say all this to give God the opportunity to move in the heart of any of our community who would want to consider donating such equipment. As a non-profit organization, any cost that we incur is passed on to the community in team and pilgrim fees. Don't get me wrong we are not increasing fees....but this cost is above what we can afford to expend in a lump sum at this time.
