The blessings that we all received on our Walk to Emmaus can be experienced again by being a member of one of the teams working the Walk. Anyone can serve on one of these teams: conference room, clergy, chapel, and outside. Cost to serve at the three-day weekend is \$165. This covers eight meals and three nights lodging. If someone serves only part of the weekend at Camp Gilmont, they are asked to cover the costs of meals and any overnight stays while working: meals \$10 and lodging \$32. You only have one walk as a pilgrim, but you can spend a lifetime as a servant of Christ, opening the eyes and hearts of others by showing His love.
