

Then one Christmas season I thought that it might be neat to pass Daddy's old tackle box along to him, so I found it, cleaned it out, polished it, and put it under the tree. The look on my son's face as he unwrapped it and heard about its story made that Christmas the best I've ever had.

That old, beat up tackle box was by far the second best gift I've ever given anyone, and likewise, giving it was the second best gift I've ever received.... The best gift I've ever received, of course, is the one we can all receive again this year as we celebrate the birth of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ through God's amazing Grace. How could there be a better gift?

However, just like I did in passing that old tackle box along to someone I loved, it is my joy and responsibility to pass on God's wonderful gift of Grace to others. Let's all remember this Christmas that the best gift is the one that we can pass along...
