These people helped me up and the women dug through her back pack to

find some wet wipes, she gave from her little to make sure that I could keep going. Later a young couple picked me up and took me to my car. Through this I was reminded that there are good people everywhere, and that we should not judge, God's angels come in all kind of disguise.
