#### **SPONSORING**

WALK #24 - WOW !! Can you believe this Community has completed 23 walks? We have come so far since that first precious walk. Many changes have come about, but changes have been made only to enhance the walks and to improve our Community.

The backbone of GRACE or any other community is sponsoring. If you do not sponsor, we will not have pilgrims to fill a walk. However, if you do sponsor and do it

half-heartedly or incorrectly, our walks will become weak and unproductive. Do not sponsor without commitment! Before you talk to someone about going on a walk, pray and ask God if He wants you to approach that person. Then take the information to them, preferably as a family, and answer any questions they may have. Do not ask for their commitment but do ask them to pray about it and give you a response later. Remember, not everyone is a good candidate for the walk. If you always allow the Holy Spirit to guide you, you will not go wrong.

Once your pilgrim has signed the application, you job of sponsor begins. It is so important to get letters for your pilgrim. Too many pilgrims do not get the meaningful letters they should have You are challenged to find addresses for their family and friends. You should mail at least 20 requests for letters in order to be sure you have at least 12. Any sponsor can get letters from people they know, but it is important to get letters from those people that are known and loved by the pilgrim.

Take your pilgrim out to eat on Thursday evening. Be sure they eat enough to hold them until Friday morning - remember, they won't have anything but snacks Thursday night. Watch your time and arrive at camp between 7 and 7:15. Be sure to take food agape for the weekend - homemade is best.

Take your pilgrim's luggage and help them find the room and place their clothes. Stay with your pilgrim in the cafeteria and introduce them to other people until send-off.

You must stay for Sponsor's Hour. Your pilgrim deserves your prayers.

On Friday, check with their family, tell them your pilgrim is in good hands, and ask them if you can help in any way. You may can baby sit or take a meal. Just check.

Check with Kim Hitt, 939-0676 or Sue Wallace, 675-6581 to see if you can help decorate or serve during the agape dinner Saturday.

Invite all of the pilgrim's Emmaus friends to candlelight on Saturday night. It is really special if the pilgrim sees many smiling faces they recognize.

Be at the camp on Sunday by 3 PM to load your pilgrim's luggage and help get the cafeteria ready for closing. On the way home, follow your pilgrim's lead as to stopping for a meal or a snack. And after you get the pilgrim home, you


aren't through.

# FEBRUARY GATHERING Thursday, February 13, 7 PM Lane's Chapel UMC, Tyler (Child Care Provided)




#### **Directions to February Gathering:**
