We also made a decision that was extremely difficult one for the board and the community. We had to cancel a Men's GRACE Emmaus walk. Unfortunately, this is a direct reflection on our GRACE community. We had twelve men who wanted to engage the Lord Jesus on this meaningful weekend. There was a team of willing workers assembled who adjusted their personal lives to provide the arms, legs, head, and heart for Jesus to the pilgrims. It was our community, each one of us, who let the Lord down. We must recall that the Lord is counting on us! We are called to support our Emmaus walks and team members by attentively listening to Holy Spirit's call, and gathering pilgrims from our churches to provide a full walk of 36-42 pilgrims. To those who did sponsor pilgrims, THANK YOU. We will be communicating alternatives with you very soon through the registrar. We are asking your pilgrims to consider walking to Emmaus during our scheduled October 2005, 6-9, Men's walk #34. Community, we have another opportunity to serve.
