Dear G.R.A.C.E. Do You Have the "Nerve to Serve"?

One of the common messages presented in sermons at my church is this: We need to go outside the walls of our Church to reach others for Christ. This is how we are to "serve God." I used to really struggle with this. Verballv professing my faith to unbelievers is not one of my strong points. (Some of you may have heard me refer to my attempts to do just that with my atheist friend in Arizona.) Galatians 6:10: "Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers." I am much more comfortable with "those who belong to the family of believers."

But I have grown and I have learned. Service is so much more than either of the above mentioned. We serve the God of the Universe, the Creator of the Heavens and the Earth. The abundance of Blessings provided to us by our God has no boundaries, it is limitless. Therefore, we cannot limit our service to Him by our human understanding of the meaning of "Service". The only way we can adequately even begin to serve God is by striving to be like Him. (**1Tim 4:8**)

Remember the talks you heard on your walks? Christian Action is every action a Christian takes. The main point of the Life in Piety talk is this: There are visible qualities in a living piety which attract others to this life. Discipleship is the giving of one's life totally as a witness for Jesus Christ. The way we conduct ourselves in our jobs, our homes, our communities, are all a reflection of our understanding of service, and of our commitment to Christ. In the same way, the things we do to increase our understanding of God and His will for our lives is equally important. I understand now that going outside the walls of my church is way more than trying to verbally share my faith with someone who may not know God. It is trying to live my life in such a way that honors God, that always and in every way will show anyone who is watching a glimpse of God. It is striving to know Him better, to love Him more, to share Him with everyone I come in contact with. Sometimes this can even be accomplished without ever saying a word.

I confess that I have not always been successful. But I am trying. The purpose of Emmaus is to develop leaders for the church. Emmaus will inspire, challenge, and equip the local church members for Christian action in their homes, churches, and places of work. I that without my Emmaus know experience, I would still be feeling guilty and wondering if I'm serving God "correctly" or enough. I would encourage each of you to examine your life since your walk. How are you doing? Have you grown through study and service to God? Have you helped someone else grow in their service to God by sponsoring them on a walk? By serving on a team? By praying during the 72 hour prayer vigil? By being active in a Reunion Group? By participating in these activities, you are serving God. You are helping others to learn about serving God. Do you have the "Nerve to Serve"?

De Colores 3 Let's Catch Some Butterflies!!

It is time for us to start catching some butterflies in the GRACE Community. In December the board signed a "Letter of Intent" to be sent to the Upper Room asking for assistance in starting a Chrysalis Community here in GRACE. We are so excited to be able to bring this opportunity to our Community. In the past if our teenagers wanted to attend Chrysalis they had to go to a neighboring community in order to accomplish this.

For those of you that don't know what Chrysalis is – it is a faith based weekend established on the same principles as the Walk to Emmaus. It is designed for Youth between the ages of 15 - 18 years old Chrysalis Flight AND 19 - 24 yrs old for college age that is called Chrysalis Journey.

The butterfly – an ancient Christian symbol of Christ's death and resurrection - provides the central image of the Chrysalis experience. This journey of spiritual growth is illustrated by the life cycle of the butterfly: caterpillar, cocoon and butterfly. Dying to what it was, the caterpillar becomes what it is meant to be. Similarly, our Christian transformation involves dying with Christ to our old self through faith in God's accepting love (Day One), rising with Christ to a new life motivated by hope in God's promises (Day Two) and going forth with Christ in love to joyfully share Christ's ministry (Day Three).

We are now in the development stages of this program and have formed a Steering Committee to go forward. BANK DRAFT INFO

The bank draft authorization, voted on by the *G.R.A.C.E.* Board in 2006, is up and running and hopefully collecting monies even as you read this article. Brian McCabe, Walk 38 LD, was invaluable in setting up this system. The Board encourages you to consider giving in this manner.

You may be thinking "Well, I'm not going to do that!" or "I want control of my money", etc... To be honest, I had some of the same feelings and thoughts – but after considerable thought and prayer, I felt convinced to try it; especially since I was going to be encouraging people to sign up for the same. Even \$1 a month adds up. It is very easy and safe.

You complete the form (provided on the last page of this newsletter and available at Gatherings) with the necessary information or attach a voided check. The amount donated will show on your bank statement as "Tyler Emmaus Community." You can stop the transaction at any time simply by written notification. (It can even be stopped for a month or two, and then resumed.) Currently there are three participants within our Please consider this community. alternative, especially if you do not make it to Gatherings. This will help each of us with consistent giving to our community.

The last Emmaus Walk costs last Fall were \$161 per Pilgrim and \$156 per Pilgrim, respectively – and the GRACE community only charges \$130 per Pilgrim. That is why we have had to with much prayer and discussion at the board meetings, have had to increase the fee to \$150.00 this year. In our efforts to keep our community strong and continue our commitment, we humbly ask that you prayerfully consider where your involvement is needed. The costs are high and the financial need great, but the reward is simply priceless.
