WOW! WOW! A NEW CAMP FOR THE MARCH WALKS!

Dear G.R.A.C.E. Community,

We are blessed to have and live in the the great community that we call *G.R.A.C.E.* Our territory stretches from Mabank to Marshall and from Palestine to Gilmer. We are approximately 1200 members strong and growing. **God is good all the time and all the time God is good.**

In order to accommodate our growing Emmaus family, we are going to conduct our March Men's and Women's Walks in a new location. We are going to be using a new camp,

Disciples Crossing

3693 State Highway 31 East, Athens, TX. (*Just about 1 mile east of the East loop of Athens, TX. See the map on page 4.*) Our October walks will be held at Camp Gilmont, Gilmer, TX.

Disciples Crossing is a lovely camp situated overlooking a spectacular lake, and camp. The accommodations at the new camp are spacious dormitory style and set up for large groups. Multiple buildings are connected by sidewalk, and the terrain is relatively level for easy walking.

The community site selection team located this facility and walk lay directors/servant team leaders have toured the camp. There is a collective agreement that this location will serve our Communities Walk to Emmaus needs superbly. We are excited about adding this camp facility to our GRACE family.

> An open letter to our Spring Walks for G.R.A.C.E. Emmaus Walk's No. 32 & 33 Team Members... Bill Burgdorf G.R.A.C.E. Community Lay Director

Welcome from the GRACE Emmaus board and community. We want to thank you for your willingness to serve the Lord Jesus on a walk team.

For our **SPRING** Walks No. 32 & 33. What an opportunity to provide a new experience for our pilgrims and our community. I hope you are as excited about being a part of the Lord's teams that will lead us forward in using **Disciples Crossing** for our **SPRING 2005** walks. Our **FALL 2005** Walks (*in October*) will be held at Camp Gilmont (*outside Gilmer, TX*.).

As you may be aware, our Walk to Emmaus follow a specific "model" provided to us by the Upper Room organization. It has been refined from the original Cursillo movement that you will learn more about. We follow this "model" as The WALK closely as possible. team is comprised of two basic groupings: the conference room team and the servant team. Both of the groups comprise the singular WALK team. Both are absolutely necessary in providing the arms, faces, and body for Jesus Christ on the walk. There are also many other persons that are involved from our Emmaus community and from the other communities supporting each and every walk. I would like to use

the analogy of a target to explain how each walk is supported. At the "bulls eye" we find the pilgrims and

our Lord Jesus, the next ring is the conference room team, the next ring is of the servant team, the next ring is the community



followed additional rings of other Emmaus communities, and surrounding the entire target is the Holy Spirit who moves, sustains, and invigorates the entire weekend.

Not one of you is on this walk because of your own volition. Oh, don't mistake me. You've made arrangements, sacrificed your time, revised schedules, and committed to work this walk. In reality, you are here because you are supposed to be here. The Holy Spirit has you at the right place and at the right time for the pilgrims and for you.

For the men and women serving as Atzyers/Angels (the servant team), your role is a unique one during the Emmaus experience. Your role is to be "invisible," going about your work without initiating interaction or conversation with the pilgrims. I am **not** saying that you need to run or hide from them, and definitely do not be rude by not speaking when spoken to, but you don't need to try to become their "buddy" either. You should try to be QUIET and in all that you do (setting up or moving tables, chairs, putting out agape, holding doors, lighting paths, etc.). And, you should always have a smile on your face each time a pilgrim sees you.

Serve them joyfully.

Conference Room, your role is to serve the pilgrims by providing an opportunity and environment for their encounter with our Lord Jesus. Table Leaders and Assistant Table Leaders your leadership role is critical. Through your actions, facial expressions, words, and interaction the pilgrims will feel engaged and active in

drawing closer to communing with the Holy Spirit. Harmony and humility are the keys; <u>this walk is</u> not about you, nor is it for you.

For the entire team, it is extremely important too keep one thing in mind –

Jesus is in charge!



However, by His grace, and He has designated the love, decision-making authority on these Walks to individuals who have accepted this responsibility - the Walk Lav Director's, the Servant Team Leader's. and the Spiritual Director's. They in turn have delegated certain areas of responsibility to Assistant Lay Director's and Assistant Spiritual Director's. All of these persons welcome your input and ideas. But, make no mistake...this is not a democracy.

If your role is not one of the previous listed leadership roles, then it is **not** your responsibility to decide how to run things. Whether you agree with a decision or not, whether it is the way it was done on your walk or not, please be cheerful, serve the weekend faithfully, and be completely cooperative.

This walk IS NOT your walk! It is the Lord Jesus Christ's Walk and the pilgrims, He has entrusted us to. The leaders were chosen because of their experience, and they will work together to coordinate the flow of the walk....trust them, and support them, and let them lead you.
