FROM OUR SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR

Every time I hear or read the words, 'Spiritual Director' in conjunction with my name, I get a little nervous. If you are like me, 'spiritual' is something you deeply desire but sure haven't accomplished, and 'director', well, just ask those who know me best about all the times I've gone in wrong directions. The idea of directing someone else seems intimidating if not quite ridiculous. I really resonate with Paul's description of himself- that he was chief among sinners. What is even more amazing is that Paul was not talking about his life before Christ- he was talking about his life while he lived as one of the greatest missionaries the world had ever known. That's where I find myself (and not the greatest missionary the world has ever known

But if those two words make me fidget a bit, there are two other words spoken boldly that make room for sinners such as me. These are the words that identify we are as an Emmaus people. The first is 'grace' as in the grace of God that overflows in streams of justice and mercy. We're here as sinners given new hope and new life in Christ. We are the redeemed called to a ruthless trust as Brennan Manning likes to call it, and obedience like no other. No one, Paul would claim, can boast in themselves. I sure can't. Start the year off right, admit it. Confess it. Celebrate it. We are sinners graced by the presence of God.

If grace is the first word, the second word is 'community'. I choose this simple definition: People who show up for each other through thick and thin. That's why sharing our lives in our churches, in our reunion groups, and Emmaus gatherings is HUGE. That's why remembering that we are all sinners in need of God's grace and helping each other along the way is the hallmark of this thing called faith. As we begin this New Year together, let me share this prayer from Common Prayer: A Liturgy for Ordinary Radicals.

O Lord whose patience is beyond comprehension, we pray that you may never tire of helping us grow in faithfulness. Though we fail more often than we succeed, raise us up each morning to follow after you again. Guide us today for your glory's sake. Amen.
