THE SPIRIT OF THE WALK TO EMMAUS

We were all moved by our Walk, "The Best Walk Ever." One primary reason is the presence of the Holy Spirit. In Galatians 5: 22-26 Paul lists characteristics of the Holy Spirit manifested in people's attitudes and behaviors. Paul called these the "fruit of the spirit". It seems to many that the "Fruits of the Spirit" are what make the Walk to Emmaus and the Emmaus Community (GRACE Community) the vibrant manifestation of Christianity that it is.

Perhaps a word or two about the specific "fruits" would help us continue our focus on making the Emmaus experience special and to the Glory of God.

LOVE-The entire weekend is an expression of God's love delivered by

disciples of Jesus Christ. It is an open and opportune space where pilgrims can respond freely and honestly to the gospel of grace in an environment where people care. The love expressed draws attention to God , not to team members.

JOY-The Walk is filled with opportunities for pilgrims and team alike to experience the joy of singing, the joy of self-expression, the joy of laughter, the joy of insight, the joy of liberation from the chains of sin/inner hurt/anger, and most importantly the joy of God's presence in their life.

PEACE- When people learn the peace of God's love and the fact that they can have a meaningful relationship with God, they can truly enjoy the fruit of peace. Team members need to carefully assess their own relationship with God through their practice of piety, study, and action. Team members strive to be themselves as they live an authentic Christian life. example, team members demonstrate the peace that comes from an authentic relationship with God. Team members motto should be "Let peace begin with me"

PATIENCE-Team members are called to have patience with the pilgrims as well as the process that God pursues in the life of others. We all need to remind ourselves that God's time and methods are not necessarily our own. Team members must remember that it is God's job to transform pilgrims. The team members' job is simply to love them and be open about their own faith stories/witness.

KINDNESS- Kindness is love expressed in specific acts of caring, attention, and undeserved charity. The pilgrims experience the kindness of God through the attention of the team and the Emmaus Community to the pilgrim's every need and their extraordinary care for the many details that make Emmaus so special a gift.

GOODNESS-The team and Emmaus Community should manifest the same spirit of selfless love and humble servant-hood on the walk that Jesus demonstrated during his ministry. Jesus did not pursue personal ambition but served for the glory of God. Team membership and community support should be understood as spiritual exercises in selfless love and Christian servant-hood. Team members need to be able to serve the pilgrims during the weekend without their egos getting in the way.
