There are several different versions of the story which inspired this song, one of which goes like this: One Spring a group of men were returning home from a Cursillo retreat. The bus they were in broke down in the middle of farm country. While waiting for help to arrive the passengers noticed the brightly colored feathers of roosters in the barnyard bordering the road. Inspired, they came up with a 100verse song which was later titled "De Colores".

On a personal note: Have you ever left a walk to Emmaus and not seen things a little differently? Maybe the colors around you seem a little brighter? Maybe the trees sway with the wind in a way you never noticed before? Maybe the air smells sweeter?
