These costs reflect Bulk ordering and shipping rates. These costs are provided for the Pilgrims at no cost, since their Walk fees cover only the cost of the camp where their walks are being held.

When we are working on a team for an upcoming Walk, if you have kept your material from a previous walk and do not need to replace it, then our publications costs can go down by not having to re-supply each item for every Walk.

Please note the Upper Room Ministries are currently printing new editions of some of the team materials. Once we have depleted our inventories that require the new material, we will be replacing the new teams with the latest publications.
