Boy's Epiphany #7 Corsicana February 10-12

We had an amazing 47 team servants and 9 super star servants for our Lord Jesus Christ this weekend. God put this team together from the

beginning. As one member had to drop, He had another within three days already to step up and fill the slot. He also blessed us with a wonderful group of musicians. I feel the music can break or make an Epiphany. This team rocked the Holy Spirit lead them throughout the weekend.

We had originally been told we would have 40 to 45 stars-(boys) as usual. The week prior to the Epiphany we learned instead of three cottages we would only be given two which brought the number down to around 30 stars. At first we were disappointed. That is until we realized by having less stars we would have an almost one on one at the table. Our 27 stars ranged from 10 to 15 years old.

We also learned that if we took the three cottages originally assigned that would mean the Epiphany, July 28-30 would be cancelled, and the boys from cottage 15 would never have the opportunity to learn of Jesus' love for them. It was all in God's hands and by his design.

Thank you for your prayers that made the weekend possible. The stars were ready to receive His word. It was evident that their eyes and hearts had been prepared through prayer before this team arrived. By noon on Friday, I REPEAT BY NOON ON FRIDAY, the boys had already begun to open up and I could see families coming together. The Holy Spirit was moving.

On Saturday night, we gave the boys an opportunity to talk to clergy. I believe there may have been between 10 and 15 boys that accepted Christ. A couple of the young men had been working with clergy at the facility for as long as two years. They rounded the corner where clergy sat and said I am ready to get Jesus in my heart. How do I do it?

On Sunday when we offered their crosses to them, all 27 young men accepted their crosses. In response to "Jesus Loves You", they all replied "and I Love Jesus".

Please continue to pray for these young men, the super stars that helped serve them, as well as all the young men and women at facilities across the state. Several of our stars found themselves in trouble this past week and said they realized it was because the devil wasn't happy that they accepted Jesus. One of them said it was because he forgot to put on his armor that morning.

To the team, thank you for answering the call to serve. This was the best team ever, in that we were one

body working together to not only spread the word of Jesus Christ, but to bring Him the glory and honor due Him. Praise Be To God!
