IN MARCH OF 2003 MY LIFE CHANGED

For many years I professed to be a Christian, attended Church, taught a Sunday School class, volunteered for projects, contributed money, and led an ethical life. I thought I was doing all the right things, but as I look back on this time I was playing a role, that of a lukewarm Christian, without a personal relationship with my Lord. Was I in for a rude awakening!

A friend at my Church invited me to a Christian weekend, Walk to Emmaus. So I went to Camp Gilmont and my eyes, just as the two men on the Emmaus road, were opened to the reality of God's love thru His Son Jesus. After Candlelight on Saturday night (what a beautiful and touching ceremony) I spent some time in the chapel and asked a close friend to pray for me, that I could come to realize God's perfect love in my life. Since then I haven't looked back, and my faith has taken me to many places I never planned to go, to sleep on the floor at four U M ARMY camps and to a maximum security prison outside Tennessee Colony, TX. You see that same friend challenged me to expand my faith by volunteering for the Kairos Prison Ministry. And I did, not knowing what a blessing I would receive from the men in white of the Michael Unit. Why do I tell you all this? Because God chose to show me His Love thru a group of Emmaus volunteers and challenged me to do the same. Jesus said that we should take up our cross and follow Him. Whoever loses his life for Christ will surely find it. And I have found mine.

http://www.michaelunit.org We need your prayers, your cookies (recipes available on web), and your financial support. It costs us around \$12,000 to conduct a weekend and we depend on the support of our community and volunteers for that money. If your Church is interested we do a prayer chain (similar to the Emmaus prayer chain) that we use to make a chain with and display in our meeting place during the weekend. Treasurer

Essentially the treasurer keeps track of all the monies of the Community. This includes sending deposits for each Walk; paying bills; working closely with the LDs to ensure that they have money to purchase Walk items needed; working with LDs and the Board Registrar to ensure all Walk Team and Pilgrim fees are paid; keeping up with the WalMart card and getting it to the right person prior to the Walk; working with the Board member in charge of the book table during the Walk weekend; after a Walk, contacting the camp director to make sure their body counts and our counts are the same, paying Upper Room \$10/pilgrim fees; collecting all Gathering offerings; locating and paying the Gathering babysitter; keeping up with 2 trailer licenses, the music, and post office box renewals; balancing bank statement each month; entering and maintaining the monthly bank draft duties; presenting a report each month at the Board meeting; and preparing a tax return each year.

Occasionally, this job also includes "gentle, nicely put" nagging in order to receive receipts from people (needed for tax purposes and audits) and when deposits come through on a bank statement and there is no clue as to who made the deposit or what it is for (team vs pilgrims). Overall, it's an interesting and, at times, challenging job. Over the past year, I have gained much respect for the Board members

who are currently serving, and have served, on the G.R.A.C.E. Board.

BANK DRAFT INFO

The bank draft authorization, voted on by the GRACE Board in 2006, is up and running and hopefully collecting monies even as you read this article. Brian McCabe, Walk 38 LD, was invaluable in setting up this system. The Board encourages you to consider giving in this manner.

You may be thinking "Well, I'm not going to do that!" or "I want control of my money", etc... To be honest, I had some of the same feelings and thoughts – but after considerable thought and prayer, I felt convinced to try it; especially since I was going to be encouraging people to sign up for the same. Even \$1 a month adds up. It is very easy and safe.

You complete the form (provided on the last page of this newsletter and available at Gatherings) with the necessary information or attach a voided check. The amount donated will show on your bank statement as "Tyler Emmaus Community." You can stop the transaction at any time simply by written notification. (It can even be stopped for a month or two, and then resumed.) Currently there are three participants within our community. Please consider this alternative, especially if you do not make it to Gatherings. This will help each of us with consistent giving to our community.

The last Emmaus Walk costs were \$161 per Pilgrim and \$156 per Pilgrim, respectively — and the GRACE community only charges \$150 per Pilgrim. In our efforts to keep our community strong and continue our commitment, we humbly ask that you prayerfully consider where your involvement is needed.

The costs are high and the financial need great, but the reward is simply priceless.
