A Word from Wynn Harle

How long has it been since you opened your Fourth Day packet? You remember that large manila envelope that was in your large white agape bag. I confess it had been a long time since I had. And then I heard a friend mention that some churches get it right when it comes to welcoming visitors while others fall short. I was reminded of the hospitality we Christians are taught to provide and seemed to recall reading a bit about this after I took my Walk to Emmaus.

Viola! There it was. In the booklet "Sustaining the Spirit" reference is made to Henri Nouwen's book "Reaching Out." He suggests that we need to learn and practice the art of hospitality. He makes several key points, not the least of which is "we can offer a space where people feel free to become vulnerable, to lay aside their burdens, to listen to their inner voices, and to begin to examine their own beliefs and the quality of their experiences." Read that again...slowly.

Fellow Fourth Dayers that is exactly what happens on the Walk to Emmaus. No matter the camp site, no matter the weather, no matter what time of year and no matter what may be going outside the Walk, our teams create a space that is built on hospitality. As Nouwen points out, it is a "gift of opportunity for the strangers in our midst to discover their own lifestyle and to find God in their own way."

As a new member to the G.R.A.C.E. community in November, 2013, I was overwhelmed by the acceptance of our members. Each walk worked has been an opportunity to share that with others, to be hospitable and to be blessed. May you all continue to find that gift of opportunity in each of your Fourth Days.

40 Years and Still Growing.....

From March 28 through April 1, 2019, we were privileged to represent the G.R.A.C.E. community as we participated along with 90 other Emmaus pilgrims from several states as well as the Bahamas and Prague, Czech Republic in the "Walk to Emmaus: 40 Years and Still Growing" celebratory Caribbean cruise. There was a worship service each morning, and we were privileged to serve communion for one of the services. We met several interesting folks, including Rev. Tommy Tucker who, while assigned in the Central TX Conference, was one of the guides who helped in the forming of the G.R.A.C.E. Community. Through discussions we were exposed to some different ways of doing some things and some ideas for change that others are considering, some of which we may want to discuss and consider for G.R.A.C.E. One of the things we heard a lot of discussion about is called "Face to Face", a program that takes the Emmaus experience into areas for folks that the weekend experience might not be possible.



Keynote speakers Stephen Bryant, Pat Luna, and Jacob & Rachel Armstrong shared insights on the beginnings, history, and hopes for the future of the Walk to Emmaus, a ministry of The Upper Room. Emmaus Ministries staff invited communities to refocus on their mission. "Renewing Christian Disciples, Strengthening Local Churches" is the new mission statement, meant to reflect on what Emmaus means for the coming years.

Add your REUNION GROUP NAME ON EACH ITEM (not church name). (The emphasis becomes the **Reunion Group**.)

REGISTRAR

In case you haven't been on the community website lately there is a big difference in the registration process. There is no longer an online application; all wholly completed applications will be mailed to the registrar's address, shown on the bottom of the application and on the website in the BOARD MEMBER section.

There are some other differences that each prospective sponsor will need to take note of. When you click on the tab to open the pilgrim application you will first find a set of abbreviated instructions to be followed in completing the application. Please follow these instructions as not doing so could create delays in having your pilgrim registered.
