Greetings and Blessings GRACE Community!

March saw God fully at work at Disciples Crossing as the Men's and Women's Walks encountered Christ in all of his glory and grace. Each Walk was, of course, "The best Walk ever!" Thank you for your prayerful support and for your physical attendance at the Send Off, Candlelight and Closing. Our physical presence as an act of agape speaks louder than our words to the hearts of the pilgrims.

Αt the April Board meeting, we were met with some of life's realities when discussing our bank balance and how many bills were due. G.R.A.C.E. **Emmaus** has expenses just like all of us do and the hard fact is that the Walk fees do not cover what it costs to put on an Emmaus Walk. Collections at Gatherings Candlelight's help and the immensely and we would not have gotten as far as we have without them. Your generosity is greatly appreciated. Besides the expenses of the Walks supplies, decorations, craft Upper Room (\$10 per pilgrim), candles, name tags, crosses, pilgrim's guides . . ., we also have to put down deposits to hold our dates for the next Walks in October (\$500 for Disciples Crossing, \$2,400 for Camp Gilmont). The point I'm trying to make is that we need your help! I know with the price of gas being so high and all of life's other needs that we all experience short falls from time to time. Ideally, \$2 or \$3 each of the 1000 from members of GRACE would go along way toward providing a cushion safe in our bank

account. Some can do more; others of you need the money worse than we do. The Board does not want anyone to be burdened, but if everyone contributes what they can, GRACE Emmaus will be able to continue to provide the quality Walks that have been such a blessing to so many.

We have not raised are Walk fees for at least 3 years, if not longer, but are in serious discussion about what the fees will be for 2007. Just like everything else, our costs have increased. We will make every effort to keep costs as low as we can, but we cannot function in the red. We are doing our best to be good stewards of all that God has blessed us with and we know that you are all doing the same.
