Qualifications for Weekend Lay Directors

The Board of Directors selects the Lay Director on the basis of his or her spiritual and technical readiness for the role of forming a team and acting as the public leader of the Walk.

The Lay Director's experience should include serving Emmaus in the background roles and on the Conference Room Teams in a variety of positions. The Lay Director should have served as an Assistant Lay Director more than once.

A Lay Director is responsible for leading the team and pilgrims through the three days according to The Upper Room Walk to Emmaus model and under the authority of the board.

Obviously, the Lay Director must be willing and available to commit the time to plan and lead team meetings, the three-day event, and to attend a Fourth-Day Follow-Up Meeting with the Assistant Lay Directors.

The GRACEmmaus By-laws say further that:

Section 3. The Board of Directors shall choose a Lay Director for each Community Walk to Emmaus weekend. Eligibility requirements for Walk Lay Directors are:

A. He/she shall have attended the Walk to Emmaus, or a similar, three-day spiritual retreat recognized by a majority of the Board as sufficiently similar to The Walk to Emmaus.

B. He/she shall have participated in previous GRACE weekends serving on the servant team, as table leader, speaker and at least twice as Assistant Lay Director.

C. He/she must be willing to conduct the Emmaus Walk as written in the Lay Director and Spiritual Director manuals of The Upper Room in Nashville, Tennessee. D. He/she must be willing to follow the guidelines of the GRACE Board of Directors.
