This will take a while, so please stay with me.

A couple of Sundays ago, our Kids Choir sang during worship. They are a precious group; from 4 to about 7 years old - and their presentations are made up of part brilliant-eyed enthusiasm, part mumbled verses and LOUD choruses, part deer-in-the-headlight stares and a lot of waves to parents and grandparent. In short, always a joy to hear - and watch.

On this particular Sunday I was in the sanctuary early and got to see them practice their song. After that was over, there were about 10 minutes until people started coming in. For a few minutes the children outnumbered their 'keepers' and they were making the most of it.

Our church has little wooden signs with weighted flaps on them that set on the ends of the pews - they have "Reserved" on them and are used to make sure there is room for special groups like the Kids Choir to sit near the front. Apparently, there is something

attractive about the sign to 4 and 5 year old girls - I noticed two wearing them on their heads. (It appeared that hair bows - large white poofy ones in particular - help keep the signs in place.)

So, picture it - little girls, smiling and laughing in church with the word "Reserved" over their heads - and see what I saw. That we all at one time had "Reserved" on our heads that maybe only our Sponsors could see - Reserved for a place on our **Walk and Reserved** for the blessings it brought and still brings to our churches and to us.

In the few months and weeks ahead, keep an eye out for the people God is showing their Reserved signs to you. Think about sponsoring them, pray - a lot - for guidance on whether this is their time - if they are Reserved for Walks 80 or 81. And if they are, sponsor them!
