- Pray, Pray, Pray for our Walks!
- Prayfully consider serving on the Walks! Team Selection will be in November, so it's important for you to get your applications in as soon as possible if you want to serve! Go to our website, <u>www.graceemmaus.com</u> -> Applications tab -> Team Application.
- <u>Pray for Pilgrims!</u> Do you know someone you would like to share this amazing experience with? Prayfully consider asking them to attend a walk. Pilgrim information is found on our website <u>www.graceemmaus.com</u> -> Applications tab -> Pilgrim Application.
- Start making agape gifts for men and women! For each Walk, we need sets of 72 identical gifts for meal table agape and sets of 36 identical gifts for pilgrim bed agape. The Light of a Candle

The light of the candles is an important symbol that reminds us that Jesus is the light of the world and that we are called to reflect His light into the world. Candlelight is a means of grace to express God's unconditional (Agape) love in a new and unique way. It's one of my favorite moments on the walk. Jesus is the Light of the world, our world, and in the world.

In Matthew 5:14-16, Jesus compares his followers to light, saying we "are the light of the world," unable to be hidden. No one puts a lamp under a bowl because a lamp is designed to help people see in dark places. Christ's words and actions showed the true nature of the world around Him.

Jesus, light of the world, let your light shine through us to break the hold of darkness. Amen.

Agape Love

Early Christian writers identified four types of love, each of which serves a unique purpose and each of which is referred to by a specific Greek word.

Eros love refers to intimacy and passion and the fulfillment of physical needs.

Storge love, which is natural affection, exists within the bonds of family relationships, such as mother or father to child and kin to kin.

Philia love is affectionate regard, where one has warm feelings for another and enjoys being in the company of that person or friend.

Agape love is unconditional or sacrificial love, the self-sacrificing love of God for the people of God and of the people of God for God.

In his book <u>*The Four Loves*</u>, C. S. Lewis describes charity [i.e., agape love] as the highest form of love. It is Christian love exemplified not only by acts of giving but also by providing for the welfare and betterment of another person through one's own selfless acts.

We are to learn from God how to love and to practice love through acts of unconditional love for all of humanity. We expect nothing in return.

Agape is, simply and purely, loving for the sake of loving.

The Outside Team – Invisible Servants

The G.R.A.C.E. Fall Walks are over but not forgotten. I served on the Outside Team for the Women's Walk #103 this fall. You need to know that it was tiring and there was a lack of sleep, **<u>BUT</u>** I want to reassure you that it was well worth the time. It wasn't my first and will probably not be my last to serve. After all, the next Walks are in March, more than enough to get rested up! The best way to become involved is to keep showing up and helping wherever you see a need. It's up to you as to how much you want to work on a weekend.

The Outside Team supports the Walk from the outside - setting up and taking down and everything in between. You can serve in many different capacities as a member of this team: part, one, or all of the days involved. You are not limited to the number of times you can work on the Outside Team. In fact, the more Outside Teams you work, the more you will understand what is necessary to support the entire Walk. Sometimes starting out working on the Outside Team right after your actual Walk can be helpful if you're reluctant to serve in the Conference Room. Also, it's an introduction to the community and how the Walks work. And you'll find out how some things from your Walk seem to just appear out of nowhere!

Teams are selected through prayerful consideration of Team Applications submitted through the G.R.A.C.E. website, rather than on 'who knows who'. Also applications should be submitted soon because Team selections for the Spring Walks will be in November in order for the next Walk Lay Directors to start their planning activities.

While working with the Outside Team, you will reconnect with "old" friends and make new friends. On Walk #103, there were about 10 veteran workers and three new folks that I worked with. We had a great time hearing a daily devotion and receiving Holy Communion as a team, sorting Agape and pilgrim letters, getting supplies for the conference room (such as, Kleenex, Sharpie markers), putting out Agape in the cafeteria and on the pilgrims' beds, and going to Wal-Mart for something needed and didn't have in the inventory. We served anonymously as much as we could and experienced God's presence in our own way.

So prayerfully consider working with the Outside Team. It's a decision you won't regret.
