Music News:

Walk early Thursday afternoon, unload and set up the equipment. This includes amplifiers, mixers, speakers, microphones, stands, and cords for the dining room and chapel. Last year, GRACE community purchased a nice Yamaha keyboard to use at Gatherings and Walks. Unfortunately, the music trailer has had some water leaks and other issues. These will be resolved by the Fall Walk. The Music Team has also had to borrow sound equipment mentioned above from Camp Gilmont and Disciples Crossing. Through the EMMAUS Board, I appealed to the Community for about \$1,000.00 to purchase a new mixer for the dining room, microphones, etc. so that we would be basically independent of the camps (we still use their sound equipment in the conference room). The Community has stepped forward and God has answered prayers. In addition to the offerings from the Gatherings, many people have made individual contributions or donated pieces of the equipment. While there are many changes that result from a walk, the walk is not intended as a conversion or healing experience. Don't forget to have the required 3 signatures on the mail-in application (sponsor, pilgrim, and pastor), and to include at least \$50.00 nonrefundable deposit. If you submit the online application be sure to follow it up immediately with the same \$50.00 deposit, sent by snail mail (an email to the registrar about the deposit being sent is most helpful),
