I just want to remind you all about our upcoming Walks #38 and #39 on October 5-8 and 12-15 at Camp Gilmont. We still have some room on both Walks, so get your applications in early. I know you are all in prayer about who God would like for you to sponsor for an Emmaus Walk. Remember, your duty as a sponsor is a major responsibility and not to be taken lightly! One of the major blessings of an Emmaus Walk is the commitment on the part of the sponsor to see that the pilgrim fully understands all that Emmaus is and then works to involve them in future Emmaus events, as well as helping them find a reunion group and a place of service in their church. Thanks for your continued support and prayer in allowing God to use you to strengthen His church through the Emmaus experience.

Another item which may be of interest is that your Board has approved the setting up of an account, with the help of Brian McCabe, to allow anyone who wants to, to make monthly contributions via an Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) just like many of you use to pay your bills directly out of your checking account. There will

be forms in this issue and also at upcoming Gatherings for you to sign up if you are interested in contributing to GRACE Emmaus to help us keep down the cost of future Walks. We have spent the past few months analyzing the per person cost of putting on a Walk and have discovered that we have not been charging enough to break even, so beginning in the Spring of 2007, Walks will be raised to \$150. This will be the first increase in quite a while, but we felt it was necessary as our funds have been stretched pretty thin in recent months. Thank you for your understanding. Don't forget, GRACE Emmaus is a non-profit organization, so your contributions are tax deductible!

Finally, our September Gathering will be held at Swan/Wood Springs United Methodist Church on 69 north across from Tyler Pipe on September 14 at 7:00 p.m. and the October Gatherings will be the Candlelights on Saturday October 7 and 14 at Camp Gilmont. I know you will want to mark these dates on your calendar and make every effort to be there.
