



His wife, a devout Christian challenged his atheistic point of view by having him turn his talents on the factual nature of Jesus. In the book he asks you to be like a juror with an open mind and wait until all the evidence is in before reaching a verdict. In the course of writing the book and interviewing over a dozen experts in a wide variety of fields, Strobel himself became a powerful advocate for Jesus. I have given this book to people who need more information about our Lord so that they can make an informed commitment.
